- The initial findings of the Research Paper on Trade and Investment Policies of Agricultural Machinery in Selected Countries was presented.



- A Panel Discussion on Sustainable Agricultural Mechanization on 17th March 2017, in Bangkok
 - Common challenges in the Asia-Pacific was shared including:
 - \checkmark a high proportion of farmers being smallholders
 - ✓ scarcity of agricultural labour in many areas
 - ✓ inadequate agricultural infrastructure such as irrigation facilities
 - ✓ low quality of agricultural machinery
 - ✓ weak enforcement of policies
 - ✓ the high-risk nature of agriculture itself



- A Panel Discussion on Sustainable Agricultural Mechanization on 17th March 2017, in Bangkok
 - It recognized the necessity of:
 - ✓ having strong support from governments
 - \checkmark a favorable environment for regional trade and investment
 - ✓ adoption of appropriate standards to ensure the quality of machinery produced and traded
 - ✓ enabling provision of financial support to smallholderfriendly practices like Custom Hiring
 - \checkmark ensuring availability of spare parts and maintenance services
 - ✓ conducting awareness improvement activities for farmers
